It's difficult and costly for a teacher or technician to make it to your house on a regular basis, keeping you apprised of your harp's condition. Bring your harp for a check-up and learn hands-on how to tune with a tuner, change a string (bass wires included) and how to maintain your harp to keep it in perfect condition. If you want any maintenance work done by Peter alone, you must make a reservation before May 31 through the director, Lorelei Barton.

** Full-Time Registration and Attending Parent Registration

This includes all activities, workshop handouts and lunches (5) from Sunday Night's Pizza/Swim through the Ensemble Concert on Saturday. The Solo Competition, Private Lessons, Harp Rental, and Housing are separate fees.

Except for the *Hear It Played*, each workshop is a 2-day progressive workshop from Wednesday through Thursday. They include printed hand-outs, are hands on with your instrument or are interactive in some way and will involve some homework outside of the workshop period.
